

HELPFUL HINTS

We recommend that you check your devices and familiarise yourself with casting well in advance of the performance time.

To play performance links on your TV you will need a Chromecast or access to your emails on your TV.

Chromecast

- If you are using a laptop with your Chromecast, you will need to open your email in the Google Chrome browser.
 - Right click your mouse and click cast and select the device you want it casted to, to share the video.
 - Or you can click the three dots (⋮) in the top right corner of your screen, click cast and select your device, to share your full laptop screen on your TV.
 - Some videos will also have a casting icon on the video (), click this and select your device.

Phone to SmartTV by either Wifi or Chromecast

- Go to the Wireless Projection/SmartView (Android)/Screen Mirroring (IOS) setting on your Smart Phone and turn it on – This is usually located in the swipe down tab on your phone.
 - This will give you the option to share your phone screen to either your Smart TV or Chromecast.
 - You may need to approve this on either your phone or TV - the device will let you know.
- Once this is done and your screen is sharing, turn on your phone screen to Auto Rotate.
- Go to your emails on your phone, open the link and make it full screen.

HDMI Cable

If you do not have a Chromecast or have email on your TV, you can connect your laptop to your TV with a HDMI cable (a HDMI cable will usually come with a games console, Sky box, etc.). By doing so you will share your laptop screen on your TV.

- You can also get HDMI cables for your phone at any major electronics stores if necessary.

Apps

There are also numerous Apps that can be downloaded to both phone and TV so that they can be linked when using the same Wifi. Examples of these Apps are Google Home, LetsView and VNC Viewer.
